Dear Excellency Robin Suzanne Quinville,

the peoples of our beautiful blue planet and thus including those of your state are facing total or at least partial annihilation for the first time since the existence of our civilisation due to the actions of a few individuals.

Without us being consciously aware of it, our home planet, in conjunction with the other celestial bodies of our solar system, is making its way through the infinite expanse of the universe.

One of Germany's leading physicists – Professor Dr Dürr – formulated one of his scientific findings as follows:

“It took me almost my entire life as a physicist to realise that there is no such thing as matter.”

This realisation reveals that everything is energetically connected and in constant communication with what we perceive with our senses. It is part of an always preserved and yet evolving energetic centre. Therefore, it is absurd to accumulate infinite power, money and material goods in order to rise above third parties like God.

Nevertheless, we currently live in a society that is characterised by the constant accumulation of financial and material wealth on the backs of our peoples, who – as already explained – form a civilizational unit.

It seems that we have not yet drawn the necessary conclusions from our own history, although our planet is covered in museums, memorials and cemeteries commemorating the victims of war and warlike acts.

Countless books and films, poems and songs have a common subject and goal: No more war. Never again bloodshed in the interest of a few.

Russia is currently accused of planning and carrying out acts of war against Ukraine.

The shift in perspective, the Russian Federation's view, shows that Russia faces a significant external military threat.

To illustrate this, please visualize our planet Earth in front of your mind's eye. Imagine the gloriously blue shimmering oceans and seas as well as the continental surfaces. You will realise how beautiful and vulnerable this planet is.

Now, in your mind's eye, visualize all the military bases of Russia, China and Iran outside their state territory. You will see that there are only 6 military bases that these countries maintain outside their national borders.

Now remember the military bases of the US outside their national borders and those of the other 27 NATO members. You will then realise that there are more than 1,000 military bases that have been placed as a perfect loop around the 3 aforementioned states. In addition, there are military bases, which are called "lily pads", as well as the globally operating military units in constant rotation, the submarine fleets, ship units and aircraft carriers, the military components in space and the secret services, mercenaries and various NGO's and other units operating underground.

Only seen from the overall view, the potential current danger, primarily for Russia, becomes evident and it does not only extend to eastern Ukraine. This is merely a fig leaf for the military conflicts with Russia, China, Iran and other states that have been planned for years.

The threat situation has intensified since 1990 to the disadvantage of these 3 states. The military threat has grown steadily and so has the danger of military intervention/ takeover. What these states and their allies have in common is that they completely or at least partially evade the dictates of dollar domination in the omnipresent financial and economic system due to their self-interests.

In 5 waves, NATO has purposefully approached the Russian borders, so that a situation of danger has now arisen, which has caused the military of the Russian Federation to demand red lines from their governments in order to avoid the danger of a first strike and the threatening total – especially military – annihilation.

As a result of this development, China and Russia will ultimately be forced to face these military dangers within the framework of an armament that is gigantic by their standards.

This is not the first time that the United States, in the context of its global claim to power, has brought, for example the former Soviet Union, into considerable existential difficulties with its armament programmes. The military budgets and the number of armed soldiers of the 28 NATO states illustrate the massive superiority of the West. However, this only applies to a limited extent to the nuclear forces. For this reason alone, Russia and China have no interest whatsoever in a military exchange with the NATO and its allies.

History has taught us that at the beginning of every war, the first thing to die is the truth. Never before in the history of mankind has the population of almost all states been disinformed to such an extent as is currently the case. The media are the most important instrument of the war hawks to play the peoples of our planet off against each other and to steer and shape the world

in their favour and – if necessary – to prepare the breeding ground for bowing to the supposedly inevitable.

The Ukrainian people are ethnically and historically closely connected to the Russian people and have been so for more than a millennium.

Certainly, there were phases in the historical development of these two peoples that were painful and associated with many sacrifices. Nevertheless, they are closely interwoven on a historical scale, e.g. in their religion, in kinship relations, in the economy, culture and art. Now these two peoples are being massively played off against each other – especially by the US – in order to create a pretext for warlike actions/ conflicts.

This approach is a tried and tested instrument of the US, which has waged in total during the same period.

However, here and now, our society is governed by capital, which is primarily concentrated in the US and other NATO member states, such as the former Empire of Great Britain, France, the Netherlands and Germany.

1% of the world's population are wealthier than the other 99%. The cause is the capitalist system which, among other things, makes it possible to accumulate immeasurable "wealth" through speculation and criminal acts, sanctions and wars.

As is well known, the capital that controls us all has the following characteristic.

"With adequate profit, capital is very bold. A certain 10 percent will ensure its employment anywhere; 20 percent will produce eagerness, 50 percent positive audacity; 100 percent will make it ready to trample on all human laws; 300 percent, and there is not a crime which it will not scruple, nor a risk it will not run, even to the chance of its owner being hanged."

Big business is in constant search of new resources that will never run dry and ultimately lead to their desired new world order.

A final event on the way to the envisaged new world order was and is 9/11. This traumatic event represents a collective failure to come to terms with the terrorist attack, unprecedented to this day, which cost the lives of approximately 3,000 innocent people.

As a result, many more innocent people died. It was the starting point for wars contrary to international law, not only in Afghanistan, but – to use the words of former US president George W. Bush – a fight against terror and the rogue states that gave aid and shelter to the terrorists of 9/11.

The former four-star general Wesley K. Clark stated in an interview on 2 March 2007 that he had insight into the planning of the Pentagon in 2001. He spoke of a "political coup d'état" in the US concerning 9/11 and of the fact that he was informed by the Pentagon about a war of aggression against Afghanistan 10 days after 9/11. 6 weeks later, he was also informed that it was intended to attack 7 more countries militarily and overthrow their governments in the next 5 years. Iraq, Libya, Syria, Iran, Lebanon, Somalia and Sudan were on the Pentagon's list of future war victims. In this respect, he relied on a memorandum from the office of the former Secretary of Defence, Donald Rumsfeld.

It is indisputable that all these wars were illegal under the terms of international law and led to massive expansion of the US military presence, primarily in the Near and Middle East.

Former outgoing US president Dwight David Eisenhower warned against this development in his farewell speech as early as 17 January 1961, in which he stated, among other things:

“In the councils of government, we must guard against the acquisition of unwarranted influence, whether sought or unsought, by the military-industrial complex. The potential for the disastrous rise of misplaced power exists and will persist. We must never let the weight of this combination endanger our liberties or democratic processes. We should take nothing for granted. Only an alert and knowledgeable citizenry can compel the proper meshing of the huge industrial and military machinery of defense with our peaceful methods and goals, so that security and liberty may prosper together.”

Despite the words of warning, the military-industrial complex of the US and other NATO members became increasingly powerful and influential in the following decades, among others on their governments. The same applies to the pharmaceutical and food industry and primarily the globally operating financial system.

Ever new plans of infiltration and war were forged in order to include the supposed adversaries and the white spots they do not control in their sphere of influence, since the military-industrial complex needs confrontation as well as the Iron Curtain used to, in order to justify its supposed *raison d'être*.

Russia and its allies, as well as China and Iran, are the states that the US administration considers diametrically opposed to its plans for domination and that challenge dollar hegemony.

The incumbent US resident Biden has already been a main proponent of wars instead of diplomacy in the past decades. In this respect, I refer to the contribution of the channel Monitor: “Return of the US hawks – The network of Joe Biden.” It is not by their words but by their deeds that they are ultimately judged. In the context of this dramatic development, words and deeds do not match.

It should be recalled that in the context of the 2014 events in Ukraine, the US was instrumental in the overthrow of the then government under Mr. Yanukovich. According to statements by Ms V. Nuland, who was Assistant Secretary of State for Europe and Eurasia at the time, more than 5 billion dollars were invested in the plans to overthrow the democratically elected government, which, in her opinion, should pay off as quickly as possible. It is also worth remembering, for example, the economic interests of Joe Biden’s son in Ukraine.

One of the chief strategists of several US presidents – Zbigniew Brzezinski – once put it as follows:

“The very existence of an independent Ukraine helps to change Russia. Without Ukraine, Russia ceases to be a Eurasian empire. It can still claim imperial status, but it would then be embroiled in conflicts with the central Asian states. China would also oppose renewed Russian dominance in Central Asia. But if Russia regains control of Ukraine, it would be an imperial power.”

One can also put in this way, that the annexation of Ukraine is a final step towards the systematic destruction of Russia.

Ultimately, the peoples of our planet will again be played off against each other in order to realise the great goal of establishing a New World Order according to the ideas of their spokesmen and their protégé.

The danger of a third world war is currently greater than ever and because of this I am addressing my letter to you with the demand that you contact your heads of state with the aim of preventing a third world war.

The current situation on our planet is largely determined by increasing inflation, an imminent financial and economic crash, caused, among others, by the unprecedented national debt.

To begin a war against Russia would also conceal its own self-inflicted existence-threatening causes in the financial and economic sector.

It is no exaggeration to say that a war between Ukraine and Russia – fomented by third parties – has the potential of a third world war and would bring unprecedented suffering to all peoples.

The first step out of this existentially threatening crisis should be a buffer zone between NATO and Russia and, subsequently, global disarmament.

Confidence-building measures must be brought about not only between Russia and NATO, but also with China, Iran, Syria, Venezuela, i.e. all the hotspots that can be the starting point of major military conflicts.

I wish all the people of our planet strength and the necessary commitment at all levels to prevent this impending military conflict, as it would end in a sea of blood and hopelessness. There is no other alternative to avoid this devastating war.

Peaceful coexistence and friendship between peoples should be the irrevocable standards of global cooperation in the future.
